VIP Project Position

Lector (Reader)

Lectors read the Lessons and the Psalm at the services on Saturday evening and Sunday. Lectors typically sit near the front of the church on their assigned Sundays and after the Priest reads the Collect of the day, the Lector goes to the lectionary where the Bible rests. The Lector moves the microphone to the height of their mouth and reads the large-type print out. If the Psalm is not being sung, the lector also leads the congregation in that reading. Lighting is available at the lectionary. The Lector must be able to read in a loud, clear voice with appropriate intonation. The readings are mailed out in advance to the Lectors with the monthly schedule. No vestments are worn and no previous experience is required. Experienced Lectors are available to work with new volunteers prior to their first opportunity to read. Lectors typically read once or twice a month. Schedules are based on individual availability. Opportunities for Christian growth include developing a mature spiritually through focused time reviewing the readings; active participation in the worship service; and potentially being seen as a leader within the congregation.
